

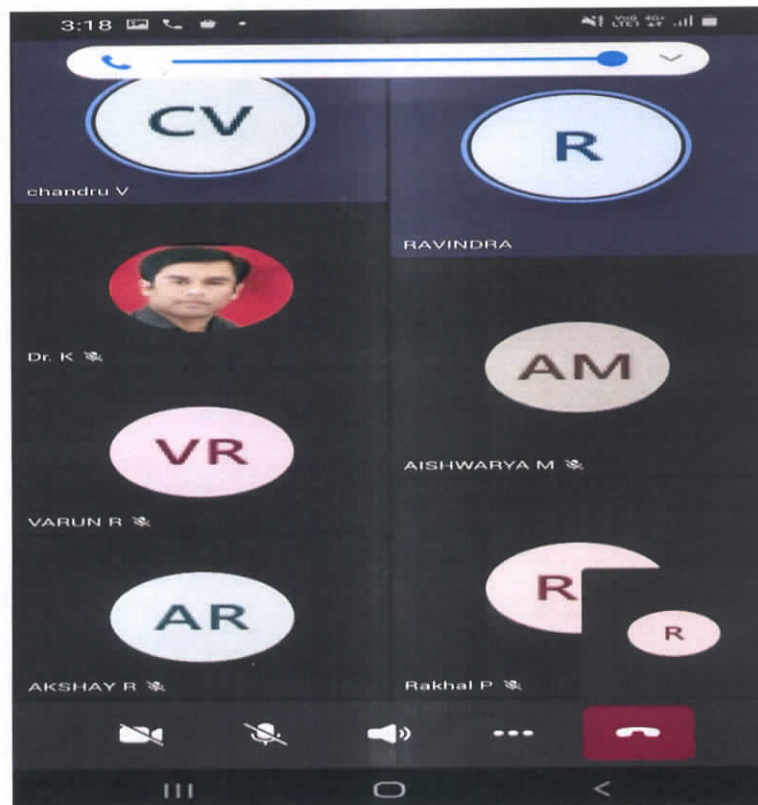


Fig.2 Students attending the webinar in the online mode

people. Without any remorse, they kill thousands of people because they don't have any conscience.



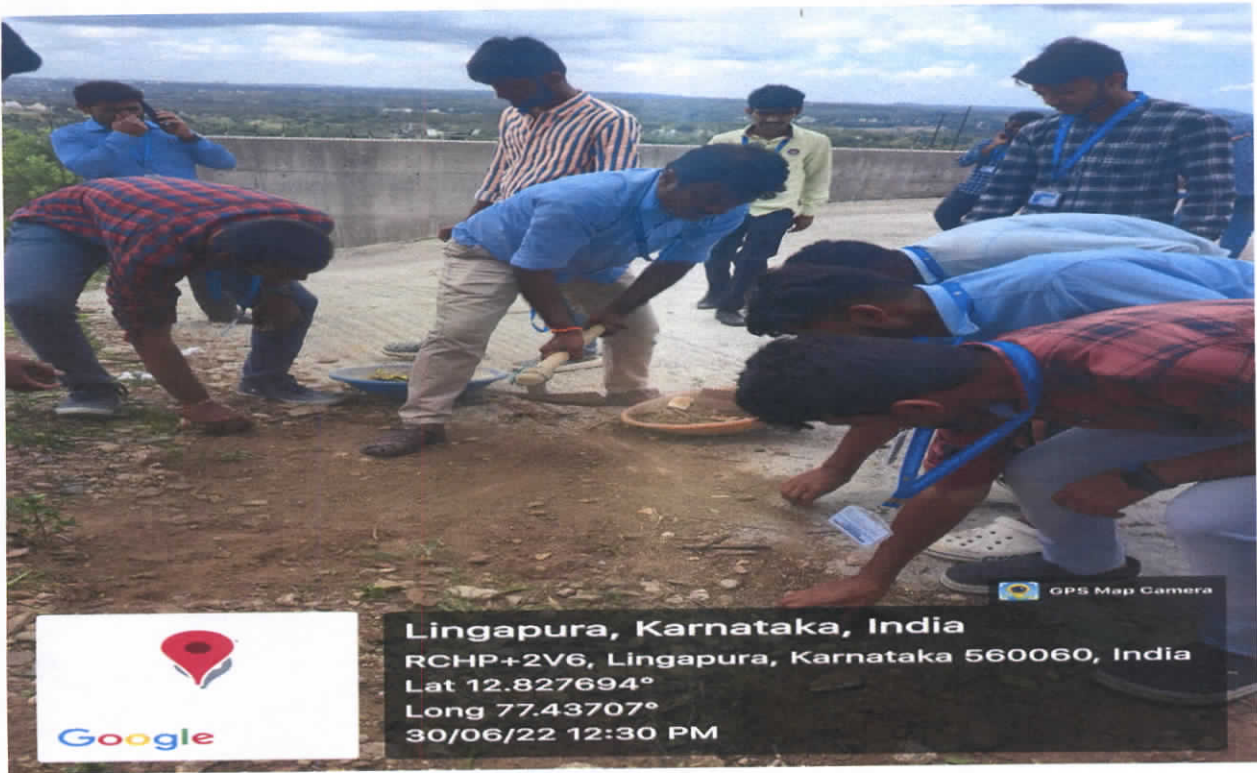


Fig. 3 Students and faculties cleaning the area





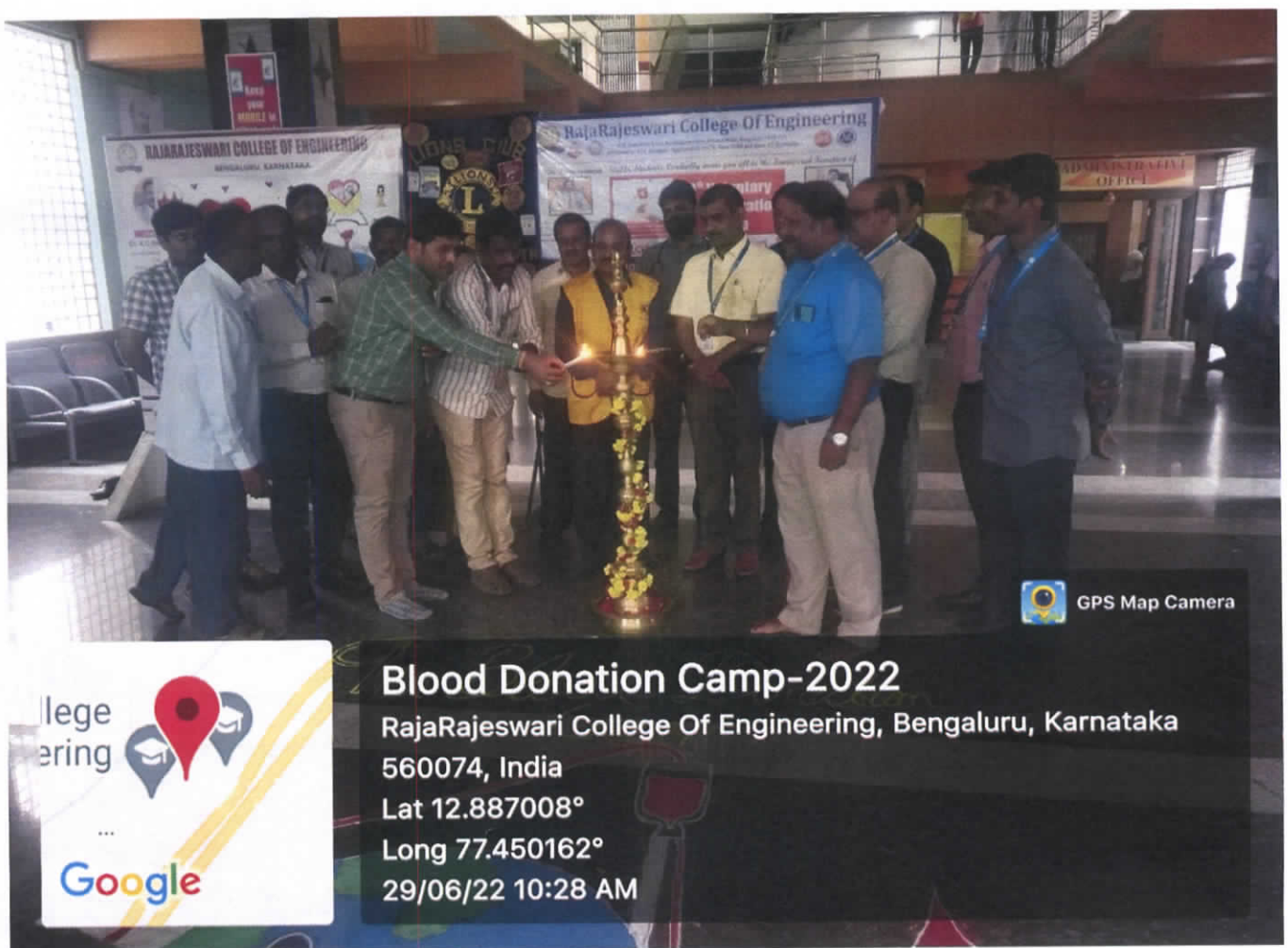


Fig.2: Lighting the lamp for 9th Voluntary Blood donation camp

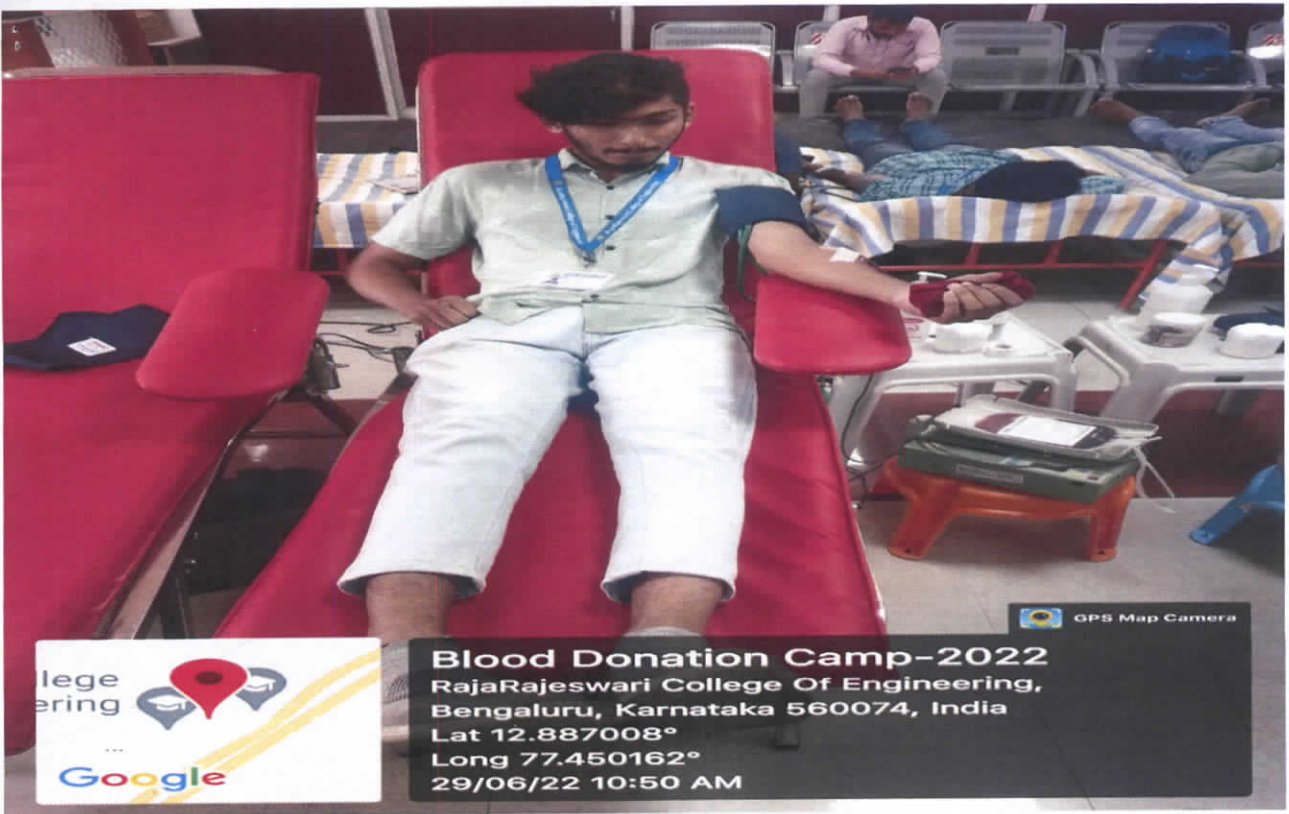


Fig.3: Students donated blood

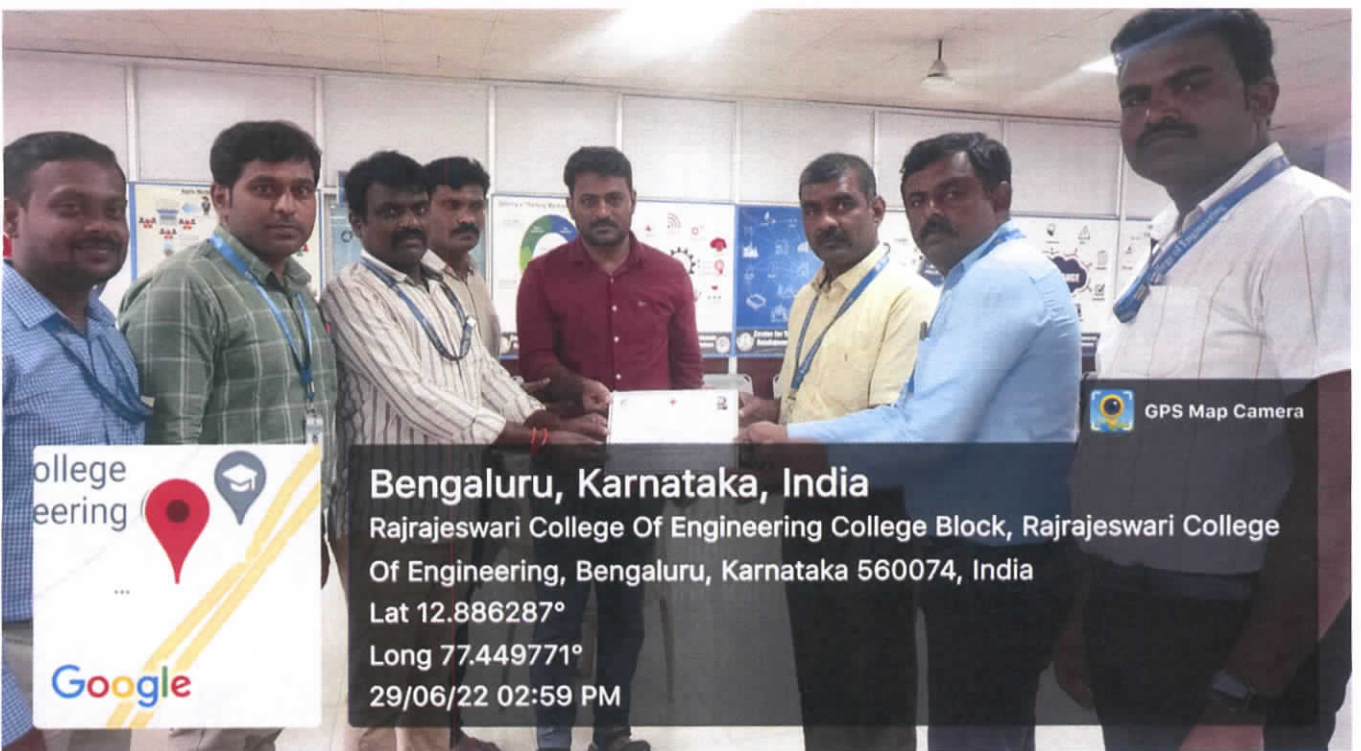



Fig.7: Appreciation certificate received from Red Cross unit
