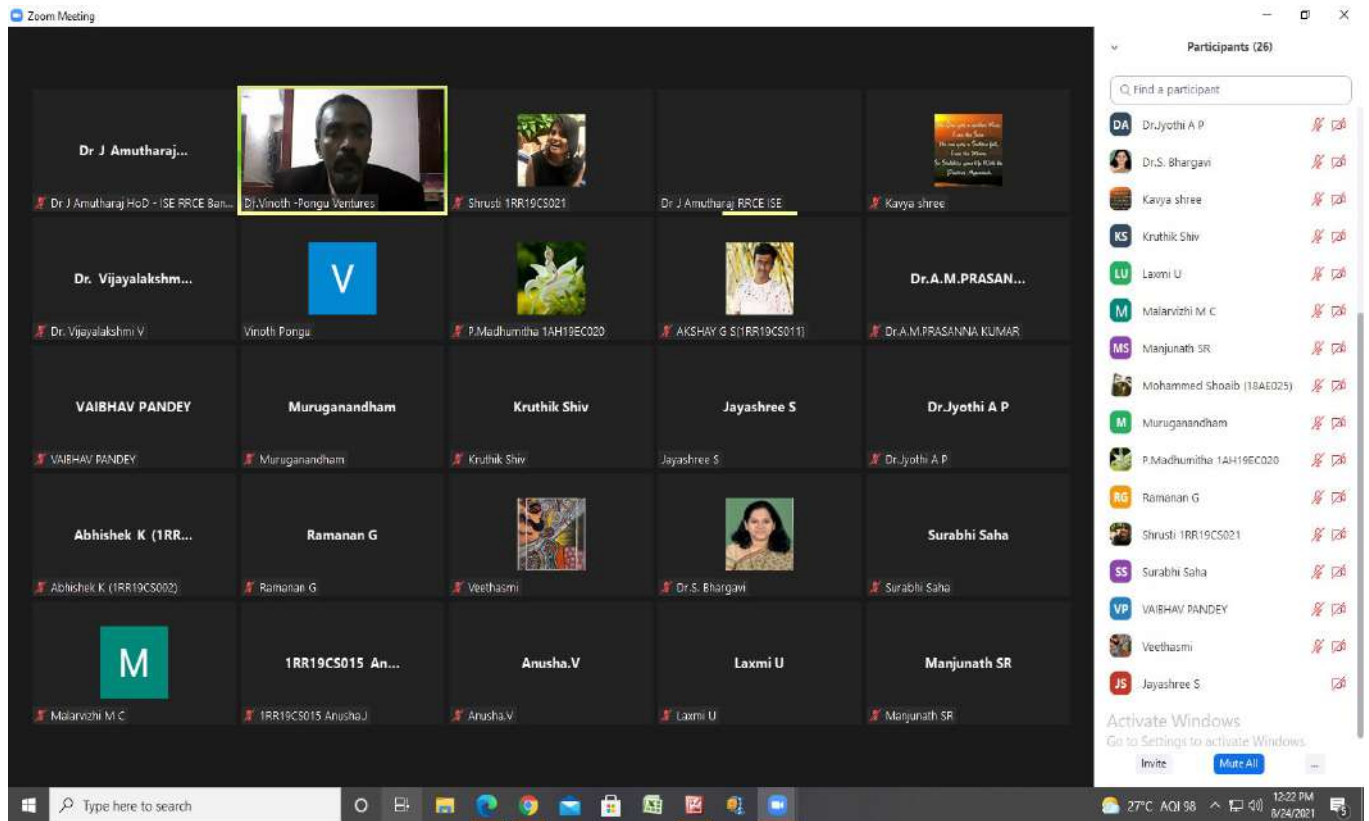

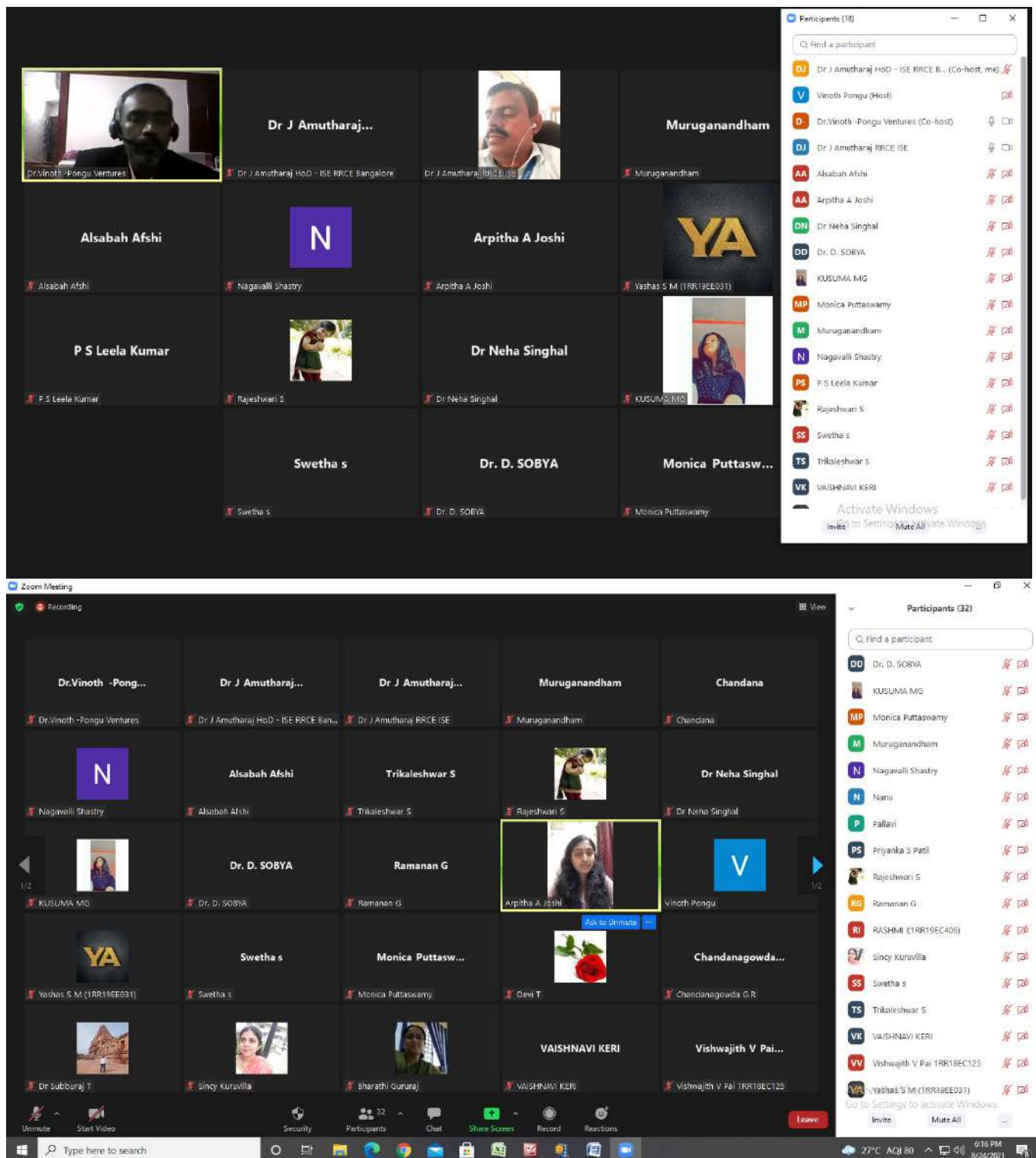

people. Without any remorse, they kill thousands of people because they don't have any conscience.



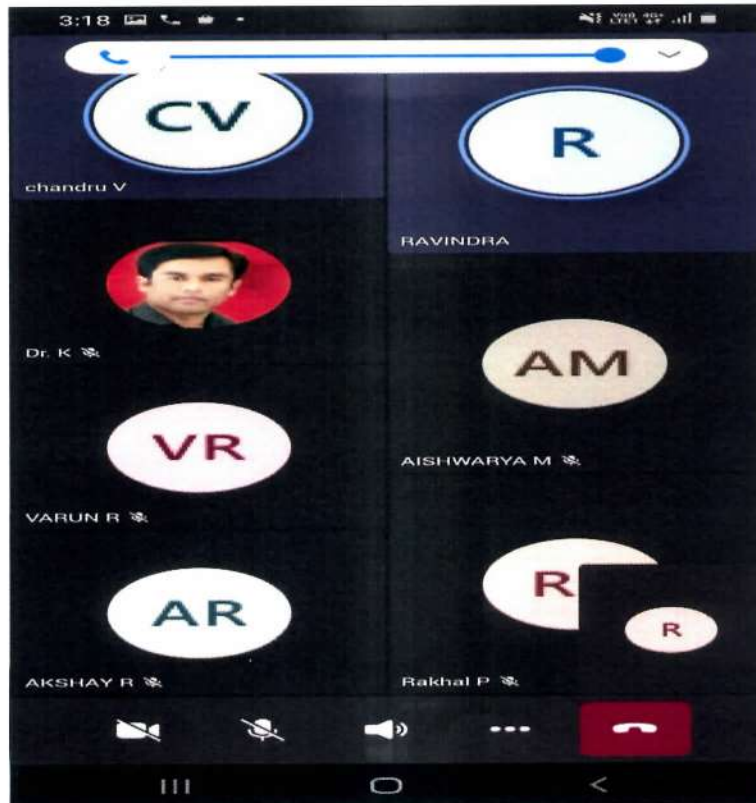


Fig.2 Students attending the webinar in the online mode
