Project Proposal Format

- 1. **Origin of the Project Proposal** (Maximum 1 page) (Scientific reason for doing this work should be elaborated) Most important part. What is after reading thoroughly regarding what is done and what you are focusing on doing in the project.
- 2. **Review of status of Research and Development in the subject**
- 3. **International Status** (Maximum 2 pages) (Researcher working in the area worldwide and their contributions must be properly highlighted with recent references and reviews. A correct and fair/delicate description of the International research status must be given)
- 4. **National Status** (Maximum 1 page) (Same as above to cover the status of Indian Scientists in the project area) It is suggested to prepare 50% of portion of 3) and 4) in tabular manner for a better comparison of scientific work already done in this area of research. See the attachment for a better understanding

Project Proposal Format

2.3 Importance of the proposed project in the context of current status. (Maximum 1 page) (Highlight what is the new area of work which will be added in the project in relation to what is already known. This is a very important section to project the novelty/creativity of the program.)

2.4 If the project is location specific, basis for selection of location be highlighted. (Maximum 1/2 page) (If the research is only for India, Asia or Worldwide, in that case you may elaborate why it is so a specific area, if it is a general research contribution for the world then you can omit this section.)

3. **Work Plan:**

- 3.1 **Methodology** (Maximum of 2 pages)
 - a) It should contain all the details of how each of the objectives will be addressed.
 - b) This section must be detailed and how data will be given, how long and generalised experiments.
 - c) It should have several sub-sections, tables, figures, equations etc. In addition to text, explanation and illustrations of why the project research plan will work.
- 3.2 **Time schedule of activities** (which will be done through each diagram) (Maximum 1 page) in which you will define your target. Now the sample proposal has having a further item, i.e. Suggested Plan of action for completion of research outcome expected from the Project.
- 3.3 **Expected research outcome/achievements and their benefits.** (Maximum 1/2 page) (Strictly this part is the definition for your project, after it you find any risk or bad impact in the achievement due to your project then mention in short.)



10 Steps: Overview

REC

- Step 1: Do your homework
- Step 2: Rigorously manage the proposal writing process
- Step 3: Write the proposal for reviewers
- Step 4: Structure (outline) your proposal as an "answer book."
- Step 5: Clearly align your project goal & objectives with RFA/RFP purpose, goal, results, deliverables
 - RFA-Request for Applications
 - RFP- Request for Proposa
- Step 6: Articulate results-oriented measurable objectives
- Step 7: Use objectives to Develop Plan of Work
- Step 8: Align budget with work plan
- Step 9: Write, package, and submit on time an impeccable proposal
- Step 10: Implement an impeccable project & meet all obligations



A Good Problem Statement Should:

- Show that you understand the problem
- Demonstrate that this is an important problem to solve, not only at Whitworth, but regionally and nationally as well
- Clearly describe the aspects of the problem that your project will address, and what gaps this will fill
- Describe the theoretical or conceptual basis for your project and your knowledge of the issues surrounding your proposed project
- Include statistical data, if appropriate
- Demonstrate that your approach is creative or innovative
- Describe how this project fits into the already existing goals of the organization

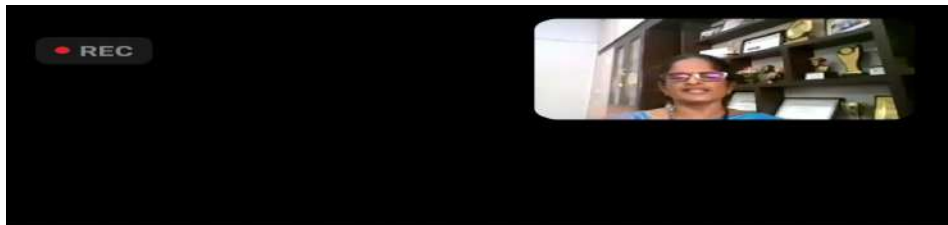
