If the scribble pad gets filled, candidates can request for second scribble pad, after returning the first one to the invigilator. At the end of the examination, the remaining scribble pad must also be returned to the invigilator.
- Candidates must bring their own pen, pencil, transparent water bottle, mask, and pocket-sized hand sanitizer.
- 8. Candidates are not allowed to bring any items other than those mentioned above. GATE authorities are not responsible for the safekeeping of candidate's personal belongings. If the candidate is found to possess any of the prohibited items, candidate will be deregistered/ barred from the examination and/or subjected to disciplinary action, which may include ban from appearing in future
- $Candidates\ will\ not\ be\ permitted\ to\ leave\ the\ examination\ hall\ before\ the\ end\ of\ the\ examination.$
- 10. Violation of any of the above guidelines including impersonation or breaking of CODE OF CONDUCT for GATE 2023 exam will lead to cancellation of candidature and/or initiation of legal action.
- 11. Candidates are required to follow prevailing Covid-19 related norms as advised by Government.
